Sean was a member of the U.S Freestyle ski team for 10 years, and represented the United States the 1994 Salt Lake City Olympic and World Championship competitions. When his turn as an Olympian was done, Sean chose to stay in the area where he could continue the outdoor activities where he excels and became the Outfitter for Promontory, the luxury mountain community in Park City, Utah. Sean works with various networks such as ESPN, ABC, and VS., interviewing winter sports superstars and our four-legged friends in the Purina Incredible Dog Challenge. In 2009, NBC invited Sean to be the athlete liaison and special reporter for the 2010 Winter Olympics, a job he has coveted for the last two Olympic Games.

In February, Sean will head to Vancouver, BC where he’ll be on the microphone and the public announcement system, using his expertise in the sport to guide the commentators in their presentations. One of the commentators, Sean’s good friend Jonny Mosley – a gold medalist at the 1998 Nagano, Japan Olympics – will work hand in hand with Sean to get the most current information from the athletes. Look for Sean performing his special reports, such as skiing the course with “point-of-view” cameras, providing insights on the venue and performing any crazy stunt NBC dreams up. His goal when commenting is to offer useful information in an entertaining way. “It’s great interviewing top athletes because I can relate directly with what they are doing. I have been in the gate at the Olympics, I have won events, and I have seen the agony of defeat. I still feel the highs, the lows and the excitement of the sport, and I can get that energy across through the interviews.”

Fortunately for Sean, his “day” job is as the official Outfitter for Promontory, Park City’s top luxury community. As Sean himself says, “I have the greatest job in the world. I get to hang out with amazing

people and do the things I love. Whether we are cruising the lakes on our Mastercraft X-45, or flying down the slopes of Deer Valley, my job is to make sure Promontory Members have an unforgettable time.” Sean will make his experiences with the athletes available to everyone online via the Promontory Club website.
