

- 1. The Conservancy will be trimming the dried grass areas along the roadways and in maintained open space areas. We are brining in extra crews to get this done as quickly as possible.
- 2. In Promontory HOMES cabin/villa areas that are maintained by the Conservancy or its contractors, the Conservancy is following the design guidelines (Section 3.20 and 3.21) as it relates to fire prevention. This includes trimming landscaping in certain zones 0-5 feet from the home, 5-30 feet from the home, 30-100 feet from the home etc.
- 3. We are trimming 10-20 feet around all of our Amenity Buildings.
- 4. We have brought in extra water on trucks to add water to our community areas and to have on hand in the case of a small fire.
- 5. We also have bulldozers available ASAP if we need to create a fire break.
- 6. We have sent out an urgent SAFETY NOTICE to every Contractor working on homes in Promontory asking for more stringent oversight on any work that might cause a spark.
- 7. We have called the Park City Fire District and asked for an expert to come out and Consult with us on what else we can be doing.

8. If you see a fire – call 911. Also call our Equestrian Gate 435-333-4035. Luckily our local Fire Dept is right outside the gate!

Here Is How You Can Help:

- 1. Please follow the design review guidelines which includes trimming landscaping as described above around your homes as well.
- 2. Please take a minute for this quick read on Utah wildfire prevention tips (https://www.utah.gov/beready/family/wildfires.html).
- 3. Please be mindful that if you park your car over any dry grasses, the heat from under your car can easily start a fire.
- 4. Please add extra water onto your property especially the dry areas.
- 5. Avoid smoking near any vegetation and put out cigars and cigarettes in safe containers.
- 6. Minimize use of outdoor firepits and fireplaces.
