Hello Promontory

No sooner than sending you all my letter about the County's plans to slowly re-open our communities, I was informed a short while ago about a situation in our kitchen. Here is our new reality as we attempt to move into new phases of re-opening services.

One of our cooks, 4 days after his last shift at Promontory tested positive for Covid-19, having been exposed at another location. This cook was healthy and symptom-free while at Promontory. He went to get tested on advice from this other location where he was told he had been exposed. This cook is now home and in quarantine having NOT returned to Promontory in the interim. However, we are going to suspend Curbside food service until Monday, May 4th out of an ABUNDANCE OF CAUTION.

Because we know that there is a silent time that the virus can be undetected, we wish to quarantine our entire culinary staff out of an abundance of caution for their safety and your safety. Therefore, we have sent our culinary staff and service staff home to quarantine. They will all be tested before returning to work. Our plan is to resume Curbside service on Monday, May 4th.

I hope you will all understand that as the County begins to re-open, we will be having situations like this occurring, which will require pods of people who have been in contact with a test-positive person to remove themselves from others for a period of time as a way to stem the spread of Covid-19. Please know that

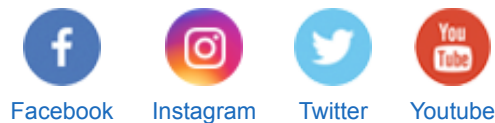
Promontory expects to verify EVERY employee's health per shift which will include some level of on-going testing as well. I expect some Members will also test positive and want to alert the community.
