Hello Promontory Golf Enthusiasts

In an effort to get you all out on the golf course as soon as possible, we will be offering tee times starting tomorrow morning, Thursday, May 7 from 9 AM to 6 PM for walk-only on the front nine of the Dye! Please read below for all the details – and there are a LOT of new details for us to open under the Covid19 ORANGE Stabilization Phase.

I have a more comprehensive letter that will go out to all Members tomorrow morning on ALL of our openings, but wanted to get this out soonest! Please contact your golf professional team at 435-333-4218 to make a tee time!

We are excited to announce the opening of our Dye Course! We have been documenting your feedback and found this is a fair option to get us going on the course even in our limited capacity. Golf will be open for Full Golf members only and will begin on Thursday May 7. The course will be available for WALKING ONLY (pull carts allowed) on Thursday through Sunday until May 17 in anticipation of the Nicklaus Course opening May 21. As required, we have modified our normal policies and practices to ensure member and staff safety and allow fair access to all members. Details on our interim golf program are listed below. We will be monitoring how these practices play out in the upcoming weeks and will make permissible adjustments as needed to improve our Operations.

COVID-19 Safety

- Make sure you are well
- Please keep a 6 ft distance from others at all times
- Do not touch your face
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue or the crook of your arm
- Wearing a face mask and gloves is recommended
- Wash hands and use available sanitizing product through-out your round
- Avoid touching anything that others might also touch
- Wash hands as soon as you are finished playing
- Do not congregate in a group
- Please follow all posted guidelines
- Enjoy the great outdoors and the views!

Tee Time Parameters

All members will be required to secure tee times to play golf at Promontory. Given the requirements set forth by the County's public health order, we will not be allowing walk-up play. The following policy governing the scheduling of tee times is to help limit congregations to parties of less than 20, enable staff to provide an enjoyable experience and Promontory to maintain all health regulations provided by the County. It is imperative we follow these procedures to have a 2020 Golf Season.

- The Dye Course FRONT NINE ONLY will open TH, May 7
 - Open TH-SU, May 7-10
 - Open TH-SU, May 14-17
 - Dye closed beginning May 18 for maintenance
 - In anticipation of the Nick opening TH, May 21.
 - Tee times will be offered from 9 AM to 6 PM
 - Tee times will be in 10-minute intervals
 - Up to 4 people per tee time allowed
- Tee times must be made via the Foretees App
 - Or by contacting the Dye Pro Shop at 435-333-4128.
- Walk up access will not be permitted at this time

Tee Sheets are open under NEW RULES for tee times

- All tee times made prior to May 6, 2020 are no longer on the books
 - The rules change was made based on anticipated increased demand for golf
 - And making sure ALL Members have a chance to play at Promontory.
 - Guest play will be suspended and not allowed until further notice
 - Members may have up to 2 tee times booked in any given week
 - Allows all Members fair access to the limited availability
- Any un-booked tee times may be reserved 24-hours in advance, even if the member already has secured the maximum number of 2 pre-booked times for that week. Example- If a Member has a tee time on Thursday and Saturday (their 2 allotted times), they can take an open time on Friday by contacting the Dye Pro Shop at 435-333-4218 on Thursday. They cannot book the time on Foretees as the restriction will be in place.

Access to Promontory Golf

To assure safety for members and staff, and to assure we comply with county restrictions, we need to avoid the gatherings of more than 20 people. Members may arrive no sooner than 15 minutes prior to their tee time for warm up and must leave the parking area no more than 15 minutes after your round is completed. All members checking in at the Main putting green (adjacent to the Golf House) must have a tee time to access the Dye Course.

- Restroom on #5 will be open for use
 - Housekeeping will clean and sanitize regularly
- The Dye Clubhouse will be closed during this time period
 - This includes no access to
 - Locker rooms, restrooms, Dye Pro Shop, Hearth, and lounges
- Dye Turnhouse will not be open or available at this time
 - Restrooms WILL be open

Golf Shop and Player Check In

The Golf Shop will not be open during our walking-only window at the Dye. Player check-In will be at the main putting green adjacent to the Golf House. Please keep social distancing of 6 feet in mind during parking and check-in process.

- Essential Items, like golf balls and gloves will be available via request
 - Available by email or during tee time reservation.
 - When booking on Foretees, IF you need any of these items:
 - Please add information in the note section for staff to accommodate
 - Glove size, ball type, quantities etc.
- Golf Staff will be regularly to monitoring that Covid19 protocols are being followed
 - Those not following the rules will be subject to a 3-strike rule
 1. Verbal Warning
 2. Formal letter from Management
 3. Suspension of Privileges

Practice Facility

The Practice facility will be open for use. We will have designated areas just for warming up, practicing and private lessons. Our new Director of Instruction, Doug Roberts, will be available for lessons starting May 15. Our other PGA Professionals will be available by appointment only.

- 9 warm up stations will be set up on the West side of the range tee
 - No more than 3 groups are allotted to be warming up at once.
- 6 Practice stations will be set up on the far East side of the range tee
 - 15 total stations on the range is the maximum allowed for distancing
- The putting green and short game area will be open for practice
 - Please keep in mind 6 ft of distancing & no more than 15 Members at a time

Carts and Push Carts

- Golf carts will not be available for use.
 - Personal carts, side by sides, golf bikes & boards are not permitted.
- Push carts will be allowed
 - We have none available but can recommend choices for purchase

Course Conditions

During the warm and wonderful Spring, Chuck and our PGA staff have worked very hard to prepare our golf courses for the season. Our original opening date was May 15th for the Dye, which Chuck and his team have worked to create the opportunity for us to open a full week early here at the Dye on the front nine. During your play please notice the healthy greens which are in superb shape coming out of winter and at least on the front nine, reduced Vole invasion from previous years.

- Flag Sticks will be fixed and not to be removed
- Bunkers will have no rakes in them
 - Please smooth out your tracks upon departure of bunker
 - If ball comes to rest in old footprint, please take free relief and improve lie
- There will be no cooler with water on the course
 - Please bring you own beverage to stay hydrated as you are at 7,000 feet!
 - You will be issued a sanitized 'starter kit' which
 - Includes scorecard, pencil, ball marker, repair tool, tees and a snack!

Thank you for your patience and understanding during this difficult time. Our main goal is to have a safe and enjoyable summer here at Promontory. Our policies are subject to change with updates from Government bodies. We appreciate your feedback and we welcome your attendance to the facility.
