Arrival and Departure

Arrival to the Nicklaus Golf experience will be adjusted to prevent added traffic and gatherings. Due to Covid-19 our staff will not be performing bag service and will require added notes on Foretees reservations to streamline your check in process. There will be no walk up play accepted, Reservations only. See the arrival guidelines below.

- Please arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to your tee time
- Please pull into the lot and park your vehicle in a desired spot
 - A staff member will greet you at your car
 - They will inquire your requested items from the golf shop and pantry
 - Placing notes on your reservation will accelerate this process
 - Example for Notes: 1 dozen Prov1x and Vitamin Water Lemonade
 - Next you can proceed straight to the Driving Range to check in with Starter
 - Reservations are required for check in
- After completion of play please proceed directly to your vehicle.
 - Please dispose of your trash in a receptacle in the Parking Lot
 - Please leave your cart at the podium area for staff to complete the sanitation process.
- Please do not congregate in the parking lot
- Depart after your equipment is placed in vehicle and trash has been disposed in a receptacle.

Tee Time Parameters

All members will be required to secure tee times to play golf at Promontory. Given the requirements set forth by the County's public health order, we will not be allowing walk-up play. The following policy governing the scheduling of tee times is to help limit congregations to parties of less than 20, enable staff to provide an enjoyable experience and Promontory to maintain all health regulations provided by the County. It is imperative we follow these procedures to have a successful 2020 Golf Season.

- The Nicklaus Course will open Thursday, May 21st
 - Tee times will begin at 9:00 amT
 - Tee times will be in 10-minute intervals
- Tee Sheet is open for reservations from May 21st through June 21st
 - Access to times after June 21st is not available at this time (*Subject to change*)
- Tee times must be made via the Foretees App or by contacting The Golf Shop at 435-333-4720
 - Walk up access will not be permitted at this time
 - Foursomes are encouraged
- Main Account Members may have up to 4 advance reservations per week
 - Allows single member to have 4 reservations or 2 twosomes or 1 foursome
 - Guest play will be permitted starting on May 21st at the Painted Valley.
 - Guests count toward allocation
 - Additional reservations can be made at 4:00 pm the day before there are open tee times
 - These must be made through the Golf Shop at 435-333-4720

Clubhouse and Dining Options

To assure safety for members and staff, and to assure we comply with county restrictions, we need to avoid the gatherings of people. Our Clubhouse and Dining options are adjusted to accommodate and provide a safe experience for all.

- The Nicklaus Clubhouse will be open in a limited fashion during this time period
 - Restrooms, Golf Shop and Peak dinner service will be open
 - Lockers and lunch service will not be available
- The Shed will be available for Lunch service
 - Reservations are required and can be made at 435-333-4622
- Nick Turnhouse will be open and available to one customer at a time
 - Housekeeping will clean and sanitize regularly
 - Restrooms will be open at #6, #10 and #14
 - Complimentary Pantry items will be available

Golf Shop

The Golf Shop will be open! We would like to welcome you to shop before or after your round. Please keep social distancing in mind during parking and when entering the Golf Shop. Please see below for Golf Shop guidelines.

- The Golf Shop will be limited to 4 people at a time
 - Any shopping will be guided by a Golf Professional or shop attendant
 - Member Charge preferred
 - Credit cards accepted
- Essential Items, like golf balls and gloves will be available in the Golf Shop.
 - When booking on Foretees IF you need any of these items please place information in the note section for staff to accommodate in a timely fashion
 - Glove size, ball type, quantities etc.
- Dress Code
 - Please remember to adhere to our Dress Code found in the Golf Book
 - Those not in code will be asked to purchase needed items in Golf Shop or return home to change into appropriate attire
- Golf Staff will be driving the course regularly to monitor Covid-19 protocols are being respected
 - Those not following the rules will be subject to 3 strike protocol
 - 1. Verbal Warning
 - 2. Formal letter from Management
 - 3. Suspension of Privileges
- Electronic Waiver
 - If you haven't completed the online waiver for club usage, please do so at your convenience

Carts and Push Carts

- Golf carts will be available for use.
 - Single rider per cart
 - Family members living under the same roof may ride together
 - Those who carpool will be given the option to ride in same cart
 - With cart inventory limited we encourage same household
 - Carts will not have scorecards, pencil or tees.
 - Sand bottles and towels will be provided
 - Towels will be dry with option to wet at #1, #6, #10, and #14 Tee boxes
 - The cooler will be filled with 4 waters before departure
 - The Starter will have scorecards, pencils, tees, repair tools and ball marks.
 - Personal Golf carts, side by sides, golf bikes and golf boards are not permitted on the course at this time.
- Push carts will be allowed
 - We do not have any available for rent but highly recommend the Clic Gear models

Golf Special Events

We are excited to still offer numerous Member events to participate in over the season. Our golf event schedule is going to evolve from the complications due to Covid-19. The ability to have only 20 players restricts our ability to perform these exciting events. See below for available options.

- Member Events still proceeding as scheduled
 - Silver Kings, Silver Queens, Nine and Dines and Junior golf.
- Member Guest events postponed
 - Duel, Showdown, Shindig, Stampede and Ladies Guest days

- Men's Play and Ladies play
 - These member events will still but conducted on a weekly basis.
 - These events DO count toward your allocated weekly reservations
 - Please use our Golf Genius software for sign-ups
- Junior Golf instruction to start June 4th and run through August 15th

Practice Facility

The Practice facility will be open for use. We will have designated areas just for warming up, practicing and private lessons. Our new Director of Instruction, Doug Roberts, will be available for lessons. Our other PGA Professionals will be available by appointment only.

- Warm up stations will be set up on the Front side of the range tee
 - No more than 3 groups are allotted to be warming up at once.
 - 20 Members and Staff on the range is the maximum allowed per the County regulations
- The putting green and short game area will be open for practice
 - Please keep in mind 6 feet of distancing and no more than 20 Members at one time
- Lessons will be available with Social Distancing required
 - All lessons will be located on the backside of Nicklaus range
- Bag stands, club cleaners, den caddies and tees will not be present on range
 - If tees are needed request some at check in from Golf Shop, Starter or Parking lot staff
 - Practice areas will be set with Pyramid ball stands
 - Chipping and Putting Greens will have a small stock of balls stationed for use.
 - Staff will clean off Practice greens

Course Conditions/Changes

Chuck and his team paired with our PGA Professional staff have worked diligently together to get our courses ready as soon as possible during the spring. We are very excited to open the Nicklaus on the 21st and the Dye in the near future. See the guidelines below for on course changes and updates due to Covid-19.

- Flag Sticks will be fixed and not to be removed
 - Our flags will have the innovative EZ-lyft attachments on them allowing your ball to enter the cup. After holing you can use your putter to “lift” the ball out of the hole using the hook attachment to the flagstick.
 - This allows handicap posting to resume immediately upon opening of the Nicklaus
- Bunkers will have no rakes in them
 - Please smooth out your tracks upon departure of bunker
 - If ball comes to rest in old footprint, please feel free to take free relief and improve lie
- There will be no coolers with water on the course
 - Please bring you own water or beverage to stay hydrated as you are at 7,000 feet!

Thank you for your patience and understanding during this difficult time. Our main goal is to have a safe and enjoyable summer here at Promontory. Our policies are subject to change with updates from Government bodies. We are expecting a revision on from the County on July 1st for the remainder of the season.
