



Hello Promontory Members,

We are happy to see so many of you on property enjoying all the Promontory amenities and soaking up this beautiful fall weather we are enjoying. I wanted to share with you some important information regarding new health protocols just issued in Utah.

Yesterday, the State of Utah issued an updated health directive regarding COVID-19 which replaces the State's former phased color-coded system of red, yellow, orange and green that outlined guidance for how individuals and businesses should behave and operate. The new directive, which goes into effect tomorrow 10/15/2020, describes a COVID-19 Transmission Index, with new index ratings of Low, Medium or High. Each County will be rated on the Transmission Index based on three weekly metrics: 7-day average percent positivity, 14-day case rate per 100K population, and Statewide ICU utilization. Currently, Summit County, in which Promontory resides, is rated as Moderate.

In an effort to keep Promontory a safe and open community for our Members and employees, we will continue to adhere to the latest recommended guidance regarding social distancing, mask wearing, sanitation, and safe gathering practices. For the next two weeks (through 10/29/2020), the State has directed that all social gatherings statewide (excepting religious services and certain events with organizational oversight) do not exceed 10 people. After 10/29/2020, new guidance goes into effect for gatherings, but other protocols for Promontory restaurants, fitness and amenity use are continuing and existing amenities will be open and operating as they presently are.

We will continue to keep you abreast of new information and best practices we are implementing at Promontory. We are disappointed to cancel our Member Mixer scheduled for tomorrow night, October 15th, as well as our annual Kids Cabin Halloween Party scheduled for October 24th, but under the current short term

restrictions, we are unable to host those larger gatherings through the end of the month.

Thank you for your understanding and for helping us keep Promontory a safe, vibrant community. We are also preparing a fun and informative video to answer some ski season questions and show how you can maximize your enjoyment of our ski lodges this coming winter season.
