

STANDARD LANDSCAPE GUIDELINES B. ROAD REVEGETATION

- 1. Protect existing native plants from construction activity
- 2. Spread topsoil in areas disturbed by construction
- 3. Topdress grubbed areas with topsoil
- 4. Reseed disturbed areas with native grasses, wildflowers and shrubs based on existing vegetation type ie: (o) oak/sage, (s) sage meadow, (a) aspen glen, (g) grassland (See Appendix A).
- 5. Temporary watering for establishment (est. one year)





- 1. 6-10' Cleared Public Path
- a. Add topsoil to areas disturbed by construction and degraded areas of existing alignments.
- b. Reseed disturbed areas with native grasses, wildflowers and shrubs based on existing vegetation type ie: (o) oak/sage,
- (s) sage meadow, (a) aspen glen, (g) grassland (See Appendix A).
