Important Promontory Update

Hello, Promontory Members,

We hope you are enjoying this beautiful autumn in Park City! With the conclusion of our 2023 golf season this week, we are now gearing up to open our Deer Valley Alpine Lodge and PC Lodge and be ready for you to hit the slopes. In anticipation of the upcoming ski season, we will once again be hosting our annual "Welcome to Ski Season" Member Mixer on Thursday, November 2nd from 5pm – 6:30pm at Double Deer. Come and enjoy time with your fellow Promontory members while previewing some great ski season wellness options from local vendors. Our Promontory Outfitter, Sean Smith (former Olympic Freestyle and Mogul skier), as well as several of our 2023/24 lodge staff will be available to answer any questions.

This year, in order to provide a more intimate viewing experience, we will be showing Park City Film's annual Ski Film, "The Land of The Giants," at The Shed Cinema on Saturday, November 18th. Cocktails at 5pm followed by the movie screening at 6pm.

We'd like to share some important information with you about how our private member ski lodges, ski shuttles, and ski/locker storage will work this year so you can begin planning your season on the slopes.



### SKI SHUTTLES & PARKING

The weekly Promontory ski shuttle schedule will be published in The Wire throughout the ski season, with staggered morning pickups beginning at 7:45am and four return drop offs at Promontory throughout the day. The last shuttle will depart both lodges at 4:15pm to return to Promontory. Shuttle service will begin running for the season upon the opening of each resort.

- Shuttle Pick up/Drop off is located in front of The Shed daily. Breakfast service begins at 7:00 am daily during ski season so be sure to stop in.
- To accommodate increased shuttle demand, we have made a few changes for this year:
  - We have added one additional shuttle to our fleet during prime season (December 20th – February 25th).
  - To better accommodate multiple Promontory families wishing to use the complimentary daily shuttle service, shuttle reservations will be limited to 4 per family (including any accompanied guests allowed during non-blackout periods). If your group exceeds 4 people, please plan to drive a personal vehicle.
- To reserve your seat on the shuttle from Promontory to either our PC Lodge or our Deer Valley Alpine Lodge, 24-hour advance reservations may be made through the Concierge at (435) 333-4000. Calls will be taken beginning at 6 am for the following day. You will need to book your return shuttle to Promontory directly at the ski lodges once you arrive.
- Park City Mountain's Base Village requires parking reservations prior to 1:00pm beginning December 15th. Carpools of 4 or more are free, but still require an advance reservation. Limited parking is available in the underground parking garage adjacent to the Promontory PC Lodge for a fee. Park City also offers free convenient shuttles from Park City High School to PCMR on weekends and during holidays when school is not in session. ### PLANNED OPENING DATES:

PC Lodge

- Equipment DROP-OFF day is Thursday, November 16, 2023 from 8am to 5pm
- Opening Day has been published as Friday, November 17, 2023 (weather dependent)

Alpine Lodge at Deer Valley

- Equipment DROP-OFF day is Friday, December 1, 2023 from 8am to 5pm
- Opening Day has been published as Saturday, December 2, 2023 (weather dependent)

### LODGE USE & GUEST ACCESS:

- Day use of the ski lodges is complimentary for our Promontory members. We hope you enjoy your time the lodges and the convenience of having a comfortable private place of refuge during your outing. Please be considerate and respectful of your fellow members and our lodge staff by storing your shoes and other personal belongings in the lockers or day use cubbies only, by not "saving" spaces by spreading out your gear, and by cleaning up after yourselves and your children as you depart your table. These simple, courteous practices will go a long way to ensuring the enjoyment of the lodges for all members.
- Each member in your family is required to scan in with their individual QR code from the Promontory App at the kiosk upon entering the lodges. Please do not attempt to bypass the check in desk or usher in family members/guests without scanning in. If you do not already have the Promontory App loaded on your mobile device, our membership team can assist you with the Promontory App at the Member Mixer on November 2nd or via phone at 435-333-4204.
- Members attempting to allow other persons to fraudulently access any Club amenity by sharing access credentials or via other means will be subject to immediate suspension.
- Daily guest fees apply for ALL guests. **During BLACKOUT DATES, NO GUEST USE IS PERMITTED IN THE LODGES. Blackout dates are December 20, 2023 to January 2, 2024 and February 17 to February 26, 2024.**
- Except during BLACKOUT DATES, Members may bring a daily maximum of 2 accompanied guests to the PC Lodge or Alpine Lodge at Deer Valley. This daily limit is PER MEMBERSHIP, not per member. Please be respectful of these guest limits so that we can accommodate all our members who wish to enjoy the lodges.
- Any request to bring additional guests must be pre-approved with the Ski Lodge Manager 24 hours in advance, and will be considered based on expected capacity/peak usage assessment. Premium guest fees (assessed at a higher rate) will apply.
- No unaccompanied guest use is ever allowed at either lodge. Please do not attempt to send your guests ahead of you to check in as this would be considered an unaccompanied guest and they will not be granted access.
- Ski and boot retrieval for stored items will be handled exclusively by our Lodge staff. For your safety, please do not enter the storage area.



## **SKI STORAGE & SKI LOCKER RESERVATIONS:**

For those new to Promontory, here is some helpful information about ski lockers and ski storage:

- Lockers at Alpine Lodge at Deer Valley are one size and measure approximately 20" high x 13" wide x 14" deep
- Lockers at PC Lodge come in two sizes:
  - Full lockers are approximately 34" high x 11" wide x 16" deep
  - Half lockers are approximately 17" high x 11" wide x 16" deep
- Lockers can be used to store things like helmets, goggles, gloves, hand/toe warmers, and other personal items. We will continue to offer some complimentary half lockers and/or cubbies for day use only at both lodges.
- Skis, boots, poles and snowboards are NOT stored in lockers, but can be stored by Promontory overnight, weekly or seasonally for a fee. This service includes the daily retrieval of your stored items upon arriving at the lodge for the day and the storage of your gear when you finish. Boots are placed on boot dryers at the end of each day.
- Should you desire to store your ski equipment at the lodges overnight, on a weekly basis or for the entire ski season, our dedicated Lodge staff will be happy to assist. As we have limited capacity for both lockers and equipment storage, a reservation process is necessary.

**Social Member Reservations Open Monday, October 30th**

Reservation requests will be taken VIA RESERVATION FORM COMPLETION ONLY and will be automatically emailed to Promontory lodge staff.

- We hope to be able to accommodate all who desire season locker or ski storage reservations, but in the event demand exceeds capacity, we will notify you.
- Until January 8, 2024, we are limiting seasonal locker reservations to one per membership.
- Please note that if you are interested in the weekly complimentary ski storage option offered by Deer Valley Resorts, you may inquire with The Ski Chalet Service for their program details.

## **ETIQUETTE & REMINDERS**

- Please be courteous to your fellow members and supervise your children at all times.
- Due to limited capacity at the lodges, we kindly ask that ski lodge use be reserved for those using the ski slopes that day. Other club amenities are available at Promontory for those wishing to use lounges or dine with non-skiing families and guests.
- **NO** outside food may be brought in or consumed in the lodges.
- Promontory will continue to provide a limited offering of complimentary snacks and drinks, including soup and cookies, for our members to enjoy as they stop in for a ski break. Please also note that soup service may be limited during peak holiday periods. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. Promontory continues to strive to deliver excellent service to our membership in all areas of the club.

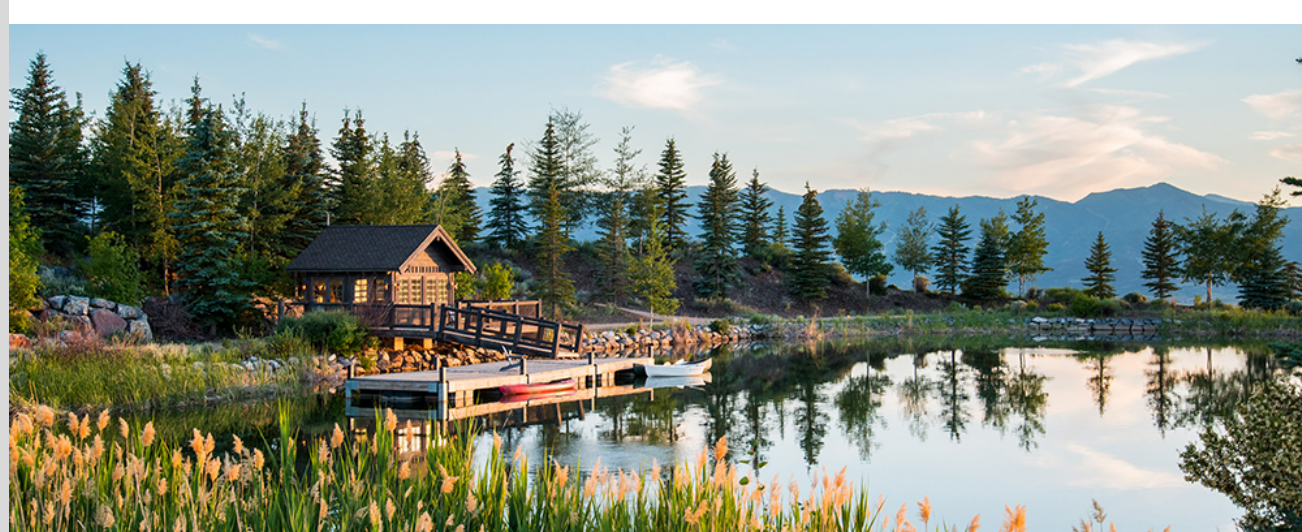
